All Saints and All Souls

This week we celebrate the great feasts of All Saints and All Souls. We remember all those countless people who have gone before us. We pray to those who are now with almighty God as saints in Heaven and we pray for those souls who are still in purgatory awaiting that prize.

The Church, as St. Paul describes it, is a body made up of three parts - each part is dependant on the other. The first is the Church Triumphant - the saints in heaven. They have reached their goal, they are with God. They can help us by interceding on our behalf. The second is the Church Militant - that is us here on earth. We are militant because we have free will, we are active and can choose between good and evil, right and wrong. We can also by our prayers, good deeds and sacrifices, help the third part of the Church - The Holy Souls. The Souls in Purgatory are saved. They will eventually go to heaven, however they can do nothing for themselves, they need our prayers to help them get there.

Masses for the Holy Souls – November Envelopes-

The best way we can help the Holy Souls is to remember them at Mass - the greatest prayer that we have. During November there are envelopes available at the back of the church. If you write a list of the names of your loved ones, place the list in the envelope and hand it into the Sacristy, these names will be placed in a casket under the Altar and be remembered at every mass during the month. If you would like to place an offering in the envelope these will be used to offer Masses for the Holy Souls.

A plenary indulgency for the Holy Souls -

This can be obtained either today, next Sunday, All Saints Day or on All Souls Day - by visiting a church and reciting the Our Father and Creed - receiving Holy Communion - going to Confession and praying for the Holy Father's intentions. A plenary Indulgence can also be obtained by visiting a cemetery between the 1st – 8th November.

ARCHBISHOP MICHAEL BOWEN RIP

As announced last Sunday, Archbishop Michael Bowen died on the 17th October, at St Peter's Home, Vauxhall, at the age of 89. He was a faithful servant of the Church and especially of the two dioceses of which he was the chief shepherd. Please do pray for him and his family.

Archbishop Michael was born in Gibraltar on the 23rd April 1930. He was ordained Priest on the 6th July 1958 and Ordained Titular Bishop of Lamsorti on the 27th June 1970. He succeeded to the Diocese of Arundel and Brighton 14th March 1971. He succeeded to the Archdiocese of Southwark on the 23rd April 1977. The Holy Father accepted his resignation from office on 6th November 2003

6.00pm: Mass celebrated by Archbishop Kevin McDonald.

8.00pm: Vigil Service, after which the Cathedral will close.

Monday 4th November:

7.00am: The Cathedral opens

7.30am: Cathedral Mass

12.30pm: Requiem Mass celebrated by Archbishop John.

The late Archbishop will be interred in the Cathedral Crypt at the end of the Mass.
