CHURCH REOPENING

As you may be aware the government has announced that Churches may reopen for private prayer (no services) from Monday 15th June.

However before this can happen there is a huge amount of work that has to be done, not least of which is a 'Risk Assessment' which must be approved by the Area Bishop.

In addition we need a band of volunteers who would be prepared to go on a rota to help with preparing the church to opened and clean the benches and other areas when it closes. The requirements are for at least two people to be on duty for the duration of the opening, these should not be self isolating or shielding.
