CARD READER - You are welcome to use the Card Reader at the back of the church, at any time. Please read the instructions in the frame above the Reader, you may not know the whole procedure for using a card. If using a card for the first time, you will be asked if you want to include Gift Aid. It is always helpful to us, as you know, if you are a taxpayer to include Gift Aid. You will be asked for the usual details, including your address. The 'Querty' keyboard will appear at the bottom and you can use this to type your details Please enter your full name, (not just initials) and (your full address), not just postcode. Once the machine has recorded your details for a given card, your contributions will always be Gift Aided. If you run into difficulties, please try to let us know, so that the machine does not get stuck on a preliminary page and prevent others from using it through the opening amount page. Hopefully, a welcome can either help you, or seek further help. Thank you.
