NEXT SUNDAY - Apologies – the Mission appeal from the MSP, The Missionary Society of St. Paul (MSP), will be next Sunday – not today as advertised in last week's newsletter. There will be a second collection at all Masses next Sunday.

MASS INTENTION BOOKING SYSTEM - You can book a Mass intention through the parish office. Please use the red and white Mass Intention envelope (available at the back of the church) or write clearly on paper and give the intention to the parish office.. The priest saying the Mass will be given a Stipend (or Offering) from the person requesting the Mass, which should be included with the Request. The intention and the Stipend are recorded together in the parish's Mass book. Please do not use the Card Reader to give your Stipend as it will simply be given to the parish and not to the priest saying the Mass. You are welcome to indicate a date and time for the Intention. The Mass organiser will do his best with this, but it cannot be guaranteed because of the number of Masses. If you have a precise date for a Mass please book it ASAP as some dates and times get booked up many months in advance. The priest is not obliged to state the intention during the Mass, although this is usually done at the beginning. As long as the Mass is said, any mistakes in printing or pronunciation do not affect the validity of the Mass. The Lord Himself knows the intention, whether it is published or not. Occasionally, we may be able to change, or swap, a Mass intention but this will be at the discretion of the Parish Priest who will take any pastoral considerations into account.
