LETTER WRITING EVENT- This deeply flawed Bill is being voted on again in Parliament on 11th September. Handwriting letters to our MP about our serious concerns is known to be very effective. We are therefore holding a letter writing event here at St Raphael's after the 9.30 am Mass next Sunday 6th September. All are welcome to join us in the Hall, letter paper, pens, stamps and envelopes will be provided.
